Timothy Park is Chief of the Food Markets Branch (FMB) in the Food Economics Division, Economic Research Service, USDA. Research economists in the FMB analyze the economic forces that drive changes within and across manufacturing and retail markets and assess how these changes in the organization and structure of the food marketing system affect food prices and consumers' food choices. Updated food price forecasts for the short-term period are regularly produced and disseminated in FMB and the FMB economists develop and monitor indicators of individual, household, and market-level food consumption, prices, expenditures, food marketing costs, and farm-to-retail price spreads. Tim joined ERS in August 2009 and also served as the Team Leader of the Farm Income Team in the Resource and Rural Economics Division. Tim previously was a Professor in the Department of Agricultural and Applied Economics at the University of Georgia and at the University of Nebraska, Lincoln.
